



The Town of Brookline is pleased to announce that our electricity supply program, Brookline Green Electricity (BGE), has been renewed! BGE is a group purchasing program, operated by the Town since 2017, which provides electricity supply options for all Brookline residents and businesses. You currently receive one of Brookline’s supply options. This letter explains upcoming changes to the products and your options.

## BROOKLINE’S NEW SUPPLY OPTIONS

Prices for all BGE products are decreasing and new product prices will be fixed for 36 months, from December 2024 through December 2027 meter reads.

**Brookline Green and Brookline Basic options will cost less than Eversource’s current Basic Service residential supply when the new prices go into effect.** As Eversource prices change frequently and future rates are unknown, future savings cannot be guaranteed. Eversource Basic Service Residential price is 15.772 ¢/kWh until January 31, 2025.

You will automatically receive the new pricing for your current BGE supply option.

Unless you have affirmatively selected another BGE option in the past, you use the Brookline Green supply option.

You may switch to another BGE supply option OR you may leave the BGE program at any time, without penalty and return to Basic Service with Eversource. To switch options or leave the BGE program, call our program’s new electricity supplier, Direct Energy Services, LLC (“Direct Energy”), at (866) 968-8065, or submit a request at [BrooklineGreen.com](https://BrooklineGreen.com).

## ADDITIONAL WAYS TO SAVE

Income-eligible customers can receive a 42% discount on their entire electricity bill, including the BGE supply prices. You can find a link to sign up for this discount at [BrooklineGreen.com](https://BrooklineGreen.com).

Customers using heat pumps as their primary heat source can receive a small discount on the Delivery portion of their electricity bill by signing up for the Residential Heating rate (R-2 and R-4) via Eversource. To sign up, call Eversource at 800-592-2000.

Participating in Community Shared Solar can provide a discount to your electricity bill, and there is no conflict with using a BGE supply option. You can learn more at [bit.ly/BGECommunitySolar](https://bit.ly/BGECommunitySolar).

## NEXT STEPS

- New rates will appear on your January 2025 bill based on your December 2024 meter read.
- Tax-exempt small business customers participating in the program must provide a copy of their Tax-Exemption Certificate directly to Direct Energy via email at [usn.taxexemption@directenergy.com](mailto:usn.taxexemption@directenergy.com) or mail at Direct Energy, Attn: USN Tax Exemption Dept, PO Box 180, Tulsa OK 74101-0180, in order to maintain their tax-exempt status.
- If you are receiving electricity supply from a competitive supplier, you may have signed up after this mailing list was created. To ensure that you continue to receive your electricity from that competitive supplier and prevent any possible early termination fees, **you must contact Brookline’s supplier to opt out of the Program.**
- At the end of the pricing term (Dec 2027), you will be automatically renewed in your current supply option, which may have a higher or lower price and a different percentage of voluntary renewable energy as negotiated by the Town. The Town will announce price changes before any such price change takes effect.

## SUPPLY OPTION DETAILS

Brookline’s current prices have been fixed for 24 months, from December 2022 through December 2024 meter reads, with supplier NextEra Energy Services. The new prices are fixed from December 2024 to December 2027 meter reads, with supplier Direct Energy. The following table compares the expiring and new prices:
